INTRODUCTION

Remove the lower case to access your MacBook Air's internals.

Step 1 — MacBook Air 13" Late 2010 Lower Case Replacement



- i Before proceeding, close your computer and lay it on a soft surface top-side down.
- Remove the following ten screws:
 - Two 9 mm 5-point Pentalobe screws
 - Eight 2.6 mm 5-point Pentalobe screws
- i The special screwdriver needed to remove the eight 5-point Pentalobe screws can be found .

Step 2



- Wedge your fingers between the display and the lower case and pull upward to pop the lower case off the Air.
- Remove the lower case and set it aside.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
