

Canon PowerShot S500 Front and Rear Casing Replacement

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


TOOLS:

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- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Canon PowerShot S500 Front and Rear Casing Replacement



- Unscrew five Phillips screws using a #0 Phillips screwdriver.
- (i) One screw is on upper right corner of the back panel.
- (i) The other four screws are on the bottom of the camera.

Step 2




- Open memory card cover by moving the slide switch toward the top end of of the camera.
- Remove the memory card from the slot.

Step 3



- Remove the rear cover from the rest of the camera.
- (i) This may require gentle rocking of the case to free it.

Step 4



 Unscrew the four Philips screws from the side of the casing and one screw from the bottom using a #0 Phillips screwdriver.

Step 5



- Free the front cover from the rest of the camera.
- (i) The cover may require gentle rocking to remove.
