

Removing the HP Compaq dx2000MT Case Doors

INTRODUCTION

In this guide you will be removing the side case doors. This is a necessary step to replace every other component on the HP Compaq dx2000MT.

TOOLS:

- Anti-Static Wrist Strap (1)
- Flathead Screwdriver (T2) (1)

Can be used instead of the Torx T15 and Phillips #2 screw drivers

- Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)
- T15 Torx Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Removing the HP Compaq dx2000MT Case Doors



• Turn off your computer and remove the power cable by pulling it straight out of its socket.

Step 2



Remove the 2 Phillips #2 screws that secure the case door to the device.

Step 3



- Remove the side case door by pushing towards the rear of the device with your hand.
 (i) This may take considerable force so keep pushing!
- Once you slide the door back, remove it by pulling it outwards from the device.

Step 4



- Remove the side case door by pushing towards the rear of the device with your hand.
 (i) Once again, this may take considerable force.
- Once you slide the door back, remove it by pulling it outwards from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
